

# Bellevue Memorial Park Survey Results

The results of the Memorial Park survey are in 3 documents.

1. **Memorial Park Survey\_Hard copy scans.** People were offered to fill out a hard copy version of the survey. These are 15 scanned copies.
2. **Memorial Park Survey\_Survey Monkey Summary Results.** The survey was also offered using Survey Monkey and a summary of the results within that document.
3. **Survey Monkey Open Ended Questions.** Four survey questions allowed for respondents to fill in a blank such as “other” or allowed the respondent to write in their own answer rather than choose from a pre-provided answer. The Survey Monkey Summary Results did not compile those responses. Therefore, below are those responses.
